- 202 An album of early 20<sup>th</sup> Century postcards, some of 1<sup>st</sup> World War vintage and others of Cologne and various cities.
- 203 A Gent's simulated snakeskin suitcase by Pioneer Luggage, 48cm wide.
- 204 A carved wood panel decorated with African style figures, 48cm x 98cm.
- 205 P Fredy – Carved soapstone figure of semi-naked man, 48cm high.
- 206 T Esfave – Four painted tin plates depicting scenes of African life, each 39cm in diameter.
