- 144 An early 20th Century wall clock in stained-wood case, 57cm high.
- 145 A bone and hardwood mahjong set in a hardwood cabinet.
- 146 A Queen Elizabeth II silver proof medallion to welcome the Silver Jubilee baby 1977, 40 grammes, in box, together with a quantity of metal commemorative crowns.

- 180 Meaby & Harvey potteries triple handled jardinière of Art Nouveau style with decorated stylized tulips 22.5cm high.

- 183 Royal Doulton 'Buckingham Red' H4971 dinner service comprising dinner plates, soup cups and saucers, dessert and tea/side plates, vegetable tureens, etc., approx 46 pieces and a matching part coffee service comprising six cups, six saucers and a coffee pot.
- 184 Royal Doulton Crystal Decanter in box, a hobnail moulded glass salad bowl, a pair of glass posy vases with white metal rims, a silver plated cake stand, two spill vases and small oval dish.
